Completely redesigned with clearer style and increased page size for ease of use. New hardcover binding gives improved durability. New research since the previous edition has uncovered much new information which is presented here. Prices extensively reviewed with many very significant increases.

King George V 'Seahorse' high values comprehensively revised following Bryan Kearsley's research, with new varieties, new shades and clearer guidance on identification. Numerous proofs essays and trials added to the King George section.

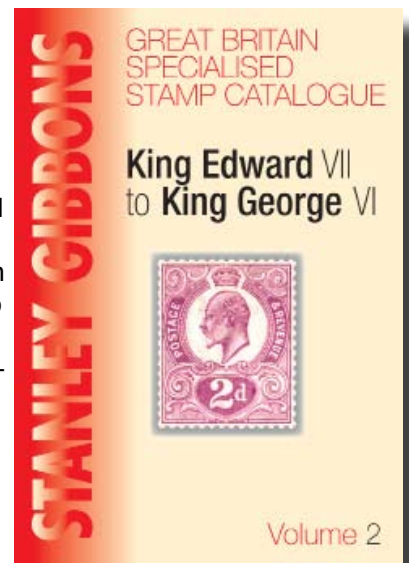
Booklet and booklet pane listings extended with expanded explanatory notes, different binding margin types separately listed and priced and full details of advertiser voucher copies. Edward VII section revised with several additions and improvements.

Background information given for all issues, with full details of plate markings, sheet arrangements, inks, papers and shades, with helpful guidance on identification.

Essays, proofs and colour trials listed and priced. Many plate flaws illustrated and priced and numerous shades, not listed in the Great Britain Concise Catalogue, also priced mint and used. Detailed listings of control numbers and marginal plate markings provided for the specialist. Helpful checklists relate specialized numbers to standard Stanley Gibbons numbers, as given in the Concise Catalogue. Booklet panes, postage dues, officials and Channel Island occupation issues all fully listed.

Appendixes cover perforators, booklets, specimen overprints, protective underprints and inland postage rates

Prices are given for mounted, unmounted and fine used examples for the period from 1902 to 1935 and for unmounted and used thereafter. On cover prices are also given for Edward VII issues.



## **Stanley Gibbons Stamps of the World 2010 edition Price £237.50 for vols 1-5**

The Stamps of the World Simplified Catalogue, lists commemorative, definitive, air-mail, postage dues, official stamps and miniature sheets. All stamps have the universally recognized and individual Stanley Gibbons (SG) catalogue number and are set out according to date of issue of the stamps, by country. Helpful introductory notes guide the reader through. Numerous updates to prices are now incorporated, including the latest Commonwealth catalogues.

Stamps of the World contains helpful information on the currencies appearing on stamps; descriptions of the designs; descriptions of surcharges and overprints; paper colour; stamp colours; se-tenant pairs, miniature sheets; and appendixes with brief listings of stamps not fulfilling the conditions for full catalogue listing. As well as postage stamps, the catalogue lists postage due stamps, parcel post stamps, official stamps, express and special delivery stamps, charity and compulsory tax stamps, newspaper and journal stamps, printer matter stamps, registration stamps, acknowledgement of receipt stamps, late fee and too late stamps, military post stamps, recorded message stamps, personal delivery stamps.

## BELIZE, GUYANA AND TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO CATALOGUE £19.95

1st edition, now available. Brand new Commonwealth catalogue from Stanley Gibbons in this popular series. Includes the early colonial listings for British Honduras (from 1865), British Guiana (from 1850), Trinidad (from 1847) and Tobago (from 1879). ## INDIA ONE COUNTRY (inc. Convention and Feudatory States), 3rd ed £22.50

Due September 2009. The most comprehensive and up-to-date catalogue of India and States on the market and considerably expanded since the publication of the previous edition in 2004. More colour illustrations, particularly in the Feudatory States. Additional priced listings of Indian stamps used in Bahrain, British East Africa, Iran, Iraq, Malaya (Straits Settlements) and Zanzibar. Numerous additions throughout the volume, in the form of helpful notes and new varieties – several watermark varieties are listed for the first time. A comprehensive design index for Indian stamps, 1947-date makes stamp identification easy.

## PART 19 MIDDLE EAST, 7th edition £42.50

Published August 2009. Design indexes improved and updated for the following countries: Bahrain, Israel, United Arab Emirates. Design Indexes included for the first time for the following countries to aid collectors in identifying stamps Egypt, Jordan, Oman, Syria. New issues listed up to and including 2009 issues, bringing it up to date. International Philatelic Glossary in Arabic for the first time as well as English, French, German, Spanish and Italian. Prices reviewed and updated with many significant increases, areas of particular interest include Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Iraq, Oman and Qatar.

## Commonwealth and British Empire 1840-1970 2010 edition

Lists and prices all stamps all stamps of Great Britain and the Commonwealth from 1840 to 1970.

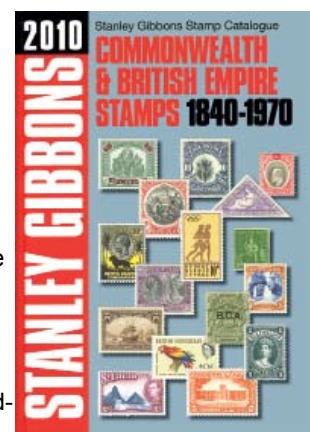
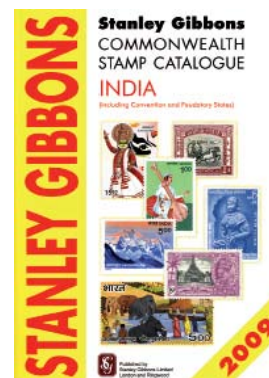
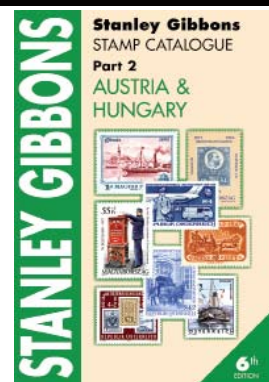
The entire catalogue is reviewed every year to take account of new research and discoveries and every price is individually checked and revised in line with the current market to keep the catalogue bang up to date.

Notable additions include a second 'B' overprint for the British Post Office in Siam, priced notes on Newfoundland imperfs, revisions to South African officials and new printing details for the Pietersburg stamps of Transvaal.

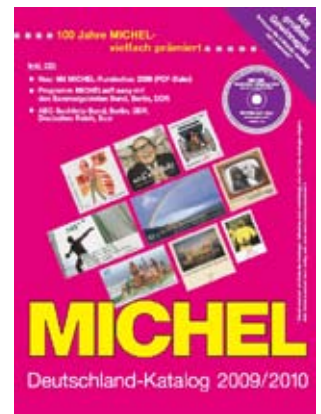

### IRAQ

IRAQ – POSTAL HISTORY 1920S TO 1940S: AIRLINES, AIR ROUTES, INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL POSTAGE RATES, AIRMAIL FEES, CHARGES FOR VARIOUS OTHER POSTAL SERVICES, CENSORSHIP AND POSTALLY RELEVANT HISTORICAL MATTERS,

by D B Armitage/R I Johnson. Published by The Stuart Rossiter Trust, 2009. S/B, 42pp.

This study of the postal history of Iraq details the surface and air mail routes, airlines used to take mail into and out of Iraq, internal and external postal rates, postage dues, WWII military and censorship mail, official mail, registration labels, and postage stamps overprinted for use as revenues. Examples of covers are illustrated in colour and maps of Iraq and some of the airmail routes are included.

The history and postal history of the railroads in Cameroon, from the first plantation railroad in 1901 through to the present day. Their construction, operation, services, timetables, and rolling stock are discussed, and a separate chapter details the use of the rail lines for the transport of mail. Black and white illustrations of the railroad postmarks and examples of covers, envelopes and related postage stamps are included.
